According to the American Cancer Society, in 2009 there were:

- 192,370 new cases of invasive breast cancer
- 40,170 deaths from breast cancer

Breast cancer is the most common cancer among women in the United States, other than skin cancer. It is the second leading cause of cancer death in women, after lung cancer.

The chance of a woman having invasive breast cancer sometime during her life is a little less than 1 in 8. The chance of dying from breast cancer is about 1 in 35. Today, there are more than 2.5 million breast cancer survivors in the United States.
